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RIO DORADO AIRSTRIP – TOLEDO DISTRICT

The RIO DORADO AIRSTRIP in the vicinity of Indian Creek Village, Toledo District, an uncontrolled aerodrome, recently underwent runway surface rehabilitation. The following are the new particulars of this Airstrip:

COORDINATES:	16° 18' 7.0" N 088° 49' 49" W Approximately 14 miles to the Northwest of the Punta Gorda Airstrip.
RUNWAY DIMENSIONS:	1650 feet x 21 feet
RUNWAY DESIGNATION NUMBERS:	09 / 27
RUNWAY/TAXIWAY SURFACE	Asphalt. (No taxiway).
RUNWAY STRIPS	Clearings of 40 feet at northern and southern portions of the runway. Beyond this 40 feet are downward slopes on both sides.
APRON SURFACE	Asphalt. Length - 100 feet and Width - 80 feet. Apron is immediately adjacent the runway.
ELEVATION:	60 feet AMSL.
TURNING AREAS:	50 ft. x 40 ft. turning areas at both runway end extremities.
STOPWAY:	50 feet. on each end.
VISUAL LANDING AID:	Windsock – south and abeam mid Runway
GROUND SERVICES:	Nil
REMARKS:	Prior to the utilization of this aerodrome permission must be obtained from the licensee at Tel: 223-3688 or 720-2004.

The licensee is Belize Lodge and Excursions Ltd. c/o Mr. Kenneth Karas. This aerodrome is for the use of single engine aeroplanes ONLY and whose Maximum Take-Off Weight (MTOW) does not exceed 12,500 lbs. The aerodrome must be used ONLY during **Daylight Hours and when Visual Meteorological Conditions prevail.**
