1. History of the flight

On 1 April 2022, TG-TAN, Embraer 110-PL, TAG Airlines (Transportes Aereos Guatemaltecos) was involved in an accident at the Philip SW Goldson International Airport at approximately 5:00 pm local time. While on departure the aircraft sustained significant damages to both propeller during the take-off phase. This was due to both propellers striking the runway surface and causing instability of the aircraft.
