**MODIFICATION OF TYPES OF NOTAM SERIES USED BY
THE INTERNATIONAL NOTAM OFFICE (NOF)
WITHIN THE CENTRAL AMERICAN FLIGHT INFORMATION REGION (FIR)**

The Central American Corporation for Air Navigation Services (COCESNA) is responsible for collecting and disseminating NOTAM information for the entire territories of Belize, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua and for all that airspace encompassed over the high seas within the Central American (CENAMER) FIR. Users are hereby informed that effective 15th November, 2016 at 0000 UTC, the following NOTAM series will be used:

Series A: For the distribution of NOTAM information affecting international aircraft operations.

Series B: For NOTAM containing information relevant only to aircraft engaged in domestic civil aviation and for national distribution only.

Series C: For NOTAM with information relevant only to aircraft engaged in domestic civil aviation and to those given national distribution only relevant to the countries of Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. (Spanish Language Distribution)

Series I: For instructional purposes. This will not be distributed to any user, however, if this type of NOTAM is received it is to be considered as non-operational.
